Word War I Study Guide

- Nationalism
 - o Extreme pride in your country, competitive tensions
- Militarism
 - Maintaining a large army that is ready for war, building up navy and army, creates arms race
- Alliances
 - Agreements between two or more countries, these are your friends, creates paranoia in Europe
- Imperialism
 - o Attempt to build an empire (colonies), rivalries, fighting for markets
- Lusitania
 - British passenger ship, sunk by the Germans, carrying Americans. Caused many Americans to want to join the war
- Zimmerman Telegraph
 - Germany's attempt to get Mexico to attack the US in 1917 in exchange for US territory. Ultimately makes the US declare war on Germany
- Treaty of Versailles
 - Required Germany to make reparations for war damages, banned them from having a large military, and forced them to accept responsibility for the war
 - o Harsh terms of the Treaty are believed to lead to World War II
- "Big Four"
 - o US, Great Britain, France, Italy
- The Spark
 - o Assassination of Archduke of Austria Hungary, Franz Ferdinand. This is the immediate cause of the war
- League of Nations
 - Promote peaceful relations throughout the world, wasn't ever given enough power to be successful
- Triple Entente (Allied Powers)
 - o France, Great Britain, Russia
- Triple Alliance (Central Powers)
 - o Germany, Italy, Austria-Hungary
- Weapons of World War I
 - o Airplanes, Tanks, Poison Gas, Machine Guns
- Armistice
 - o Cease-fire, happened on November 11, 1918
- Trench Warfare
 - o Dig in and fight from trenches, stalemate- neither side gains anything
