	Allies begin a nine-month battle for the Turkish peninsula of Gallipoli.

	Armenian Genocide begins.
	At eleven o'clock on this day, war on the western Front ends as Germany and the Allies sign an Armistice.
	Austria-Hungary declares war on Russia.
	British cryptographers decipher a telegram from German Foreign Minister Arthur Zimmermann to the German Minister of Mexico.
	British nurse, Edith Cavell, is executed by the Germans.
	Emperor Franz Joseph of Austria-Hungary declares war on Serbia.
	Emperor Karl of Austria abdicates.
	German invasion of France is halted at the First Battle of the Marne.
	Germans on the banks of the Marne near Paris are stopped by American forces at Chateau-Thierry.
	Germany and Allies sign the Treaty of Versailles. The U.S. Senate later refuses to ratify it.
	Germany declares war on neutral Belgium and invades Belgium and Luxemburg as part of their Schlieffen Plan to quickly defeat France and avoid a two-front war. As a result, Great Britain declares war on Germany.
	Italy Joins the Allies.
	Kaiser Wilhelm II of Germany abdicates.
